Greetings Families,

Just a couple of housekeeping items that need addressed at this stage of the school year.

We (nurses) are in the process of reviewing student health forms to ensure we are informed, aware and prepared for any medical/health issues that may need our attention or action in an emergency. If your child has **asthma** or a **severe allergy** (i.e. Peanuts/Nuts, Wasps/Bees), be sure the school office has the appropriate medications (Benadryl, EpiPen, Inhaler) on hand. Please check the expiration dates on all medications before leaving them at the school.

In some circumstances a child may self monitor their symptoms and carry their inhaler. Please talk to your school nurse to determine if your child is eligible.

Children going into 7th grade must meet the following minimum immunization requirements in addition to the school entry requirements:

- (1) Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)
- (1) Meningococcal

Please visit with your child's healthcare provider about these requirements. If your child is in need of immunizations contact your physician or Central District Health Department for clinic hours. As immunizations are updated, please provide the school nurse with a current copy.

If your child is not immunized, by law, you must complete an exemption form each year. The form is turned in to your school nurse and kept on file. This information is extremely important in case of an outbreak.
